He also served on the State of Georgia's Solid Waste Planning Task Force, on the Atlanta Chamber of Commerce's Water Quality Task Force and as Chairman of the Solid Waste Task Force. He led the Environmental Collaborative of the Atlanta Regional Commission's award-winning Vision 2020 planning effort. He teaches environmental law as a part-time instructor at the Georgia Institute of Technology.
